









- **Please choose your courses carefully.** The timetable is built based on your choices now. In the fall, there may not be space to allow you to change your mind, and inadequate demand now could result in a course you want being cancelled if you don't indicate your desire to take it now.
- **Required courses,** choose an option for the following required course areas:
 - English 10
 - Social Studies 10
 - Mathematics 10
 - Science 10
 - Physical Education 10
 - Planning 10
- Students must also choose **2 Elective courses and 2 alternates.**
- All grade 10 students are required to have a complete timetable of 8 courses (6 required, 2 elective).
- **Study blocks:** There are no study blocks for grade 10 students. In extenuating circumstance, the administration may place a grade 10 student in a study block with a class.
- **Hockey Academy:** If you select a HOCKEY ACADEMY option as your PE course:
 - You must contact Mr. Ponak to sign up for the Hockey Academy (if you haven't already signed up for the Rivermen Hockey Academy).
 - Be advised that joining the Rivermen Hockey Academy carries a financial cost (approx. \$2000)
- **Outside the Timetable Electives:** If you would like Extra Curricular Electives, these will not be scheduled in your timetable, there will be sign ups / auditions in September. Please select the course(s) in the Outside of the Timetable option. This will be an indication of your interest at this time only.
- **Summer School:** If students are planning to take a course in summer school, please include which course you are planning to take in the [counsellor memo](#) at the bottom.
- **Online Courses:** If students are taking or planning to take an online course, please include which course and school in the [counsellor memo](#) at the bottom.



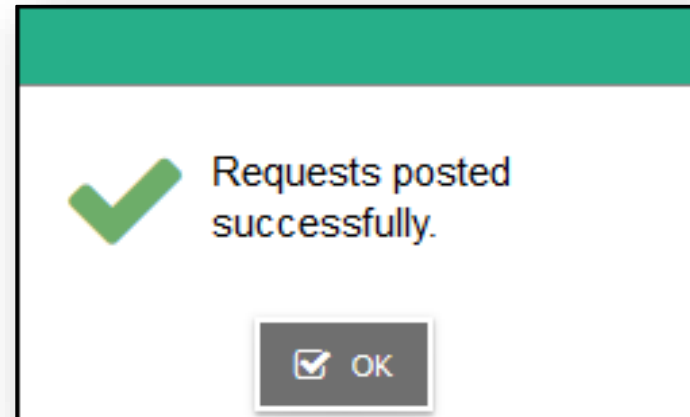
In order to confirm that you have completed your course selections, **click the POST button** in the bottom left of the screen.
